MILITARY ARREST.—We are informed that Captain De la Mesa, with a file of men, arrested, on Saturday last, Mr. Yancey White, living in the vicinity of Thomas' Mills, in this county, charged with the crime of murder. We are told that the negro woman who disappeared from the neighborhood, and who he is charged with having murdered, is alive in Alabama, and is "as well as could be expected under the circumstances."

Mr. White is now under arrest at this place, and we presume the case will undergo legal investigation in a few days.—*Rome Courier.*
